On 24th July we had the official “turning of the sod” at Queen’s Park, Bunbury where the memorial will be installed. This milestone event was attended by committee members with Mayor Gary Brennan, council representatives and contractors. Local media were also there to capture the moment.

Site work will now get underway in preparation for underground electrical cabling and the foundation. Manufacturing of sculpture components is all but completed, with only minor elements still to make.
