## Opening Day Gala Event

On Saturday 24th November, the opening of the memorial sculpture was an outstanding success. Well in excess of 2000 people were in attendance over the afternoon. There has been excellent feedback regarding many aspects of the day and the memorial itself. Thank you to everyone who had a hand in making the afternoon run so smoothly and successfully.

The completion of the project was assisted by the co-operation of the City of Bunbury who helped with last minute landscaping to ensure the site was ready for the opening afternoon. Flags were provided by the Bunbury Multicultural Society which were great decorations, adding a festive flavour to the area. The stalls were well patronised and the stage performances were very well received. The commemorative souvenir booklet was a hit with about 1100 sold on the day. There are still some available from Charlie's office, or the Visitor Centre at the City of Bunbury.

There are plans for a second stage of the memorial to accomodate the names of people who didn't make it into the first round. This is expected to get underway sometime in mid 2019.
